2. The Stewart family are going on holiday for a fortnight. The family consists of two adults and two children aged 4 and 1.

They have a budget of $£ 3200$ for their holiday.
They need to book flights, accommodation, travel insurance and need $£ 90$ spending money per day.

They need to book flights, accommodation, and want $£ 60$ spending money per day.
